

Free Early Education Entitlement

The Government provides funded education for all 3 and 4 year olds. All children age 3 and 4 are entitled for up to 15 hours a week for 38 weeks per academic year, however some may be eligible for 30 hours—please check eligibility and criteria with our preschool office.

The dates to determine eligibility are as follows:-

Children born between

1 April to 31 August is eligible for a free place from the start of Term 1 in September following 3rd birthday

1 Sept to 31 Dec is eligible for a free place from the start of Term 3 in January following 3rd birthday

1 Jan to 31 Mar is eligible for a free place from the start of Term 5 in April following 3rd birthday

N.B. The first 5 sessions of a child's allocation will be covered by their Free Early Education Funding
